Abstract:	
Scope and Content:	The collection consists of materials created by the Greater Durham Chamber of Commerce and a few records of the organization . The materials relate not only to the organization's activities and presence in the community, but also to the changing economic landscape of Durham. Included are slides dating from 19xx-19xx of sites all around Durham, various publications that contain membership listings and guides for buyers, businesses, and new residents, as well as programs and invitations relating to community events that the Chamber of Commerce hosted. The collection also contains two scrapbooks of newspaper articles, one concerning a possible merger of the Durham city and county governments and another concerning the industrial and commercial expansion of Research Triangle Park during 1968. Provided with the scrapbooks were sections of the April 26, 1953, Durham Morning Herald, which celebrated the city's centennial by providing histories and snapshots of Durham churches, sports, businesses, the Chamber of Commerce itself, and women's organizations. The collection also contains an insert from the February 23, 1924, issue of the Durham Morning Herald , which features histories of the Rotary, Lions, and Kiwanis clubs. Because the 1953 issue has been microfilmed, the original was discarded, while the 1924 insert was retained.
