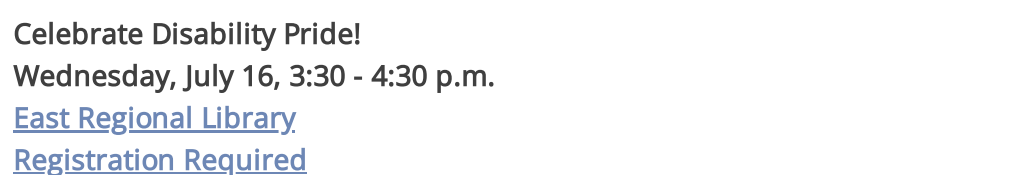
Design your very own custom shoe! Each person gets one shoe to decorate using paint, embroidery thread, and the other materials provided.

Celebrate Disability Pride!



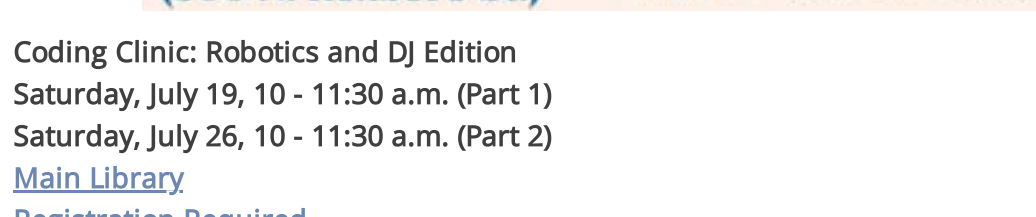
