**Durham County Library to Modify Opening Hours**


On Monday, September 8, our [Bragtown Branch Library](#) will be updating their Monday hours to open from 10 a.m. - 6 p.m. The Bragtown Branch Library will now be open Monday - Friday, 10 a.m. - 6 p.m. What the Bragtown branch lacks in size, it makes up for in the resources it offers the community! Historical documents and photographs on the walls trace the location's history back to the 1960s, when it opened as a branch of the African American Stanford L. Warren Library. Today, free public computers, sensory tools, and a community garden space outside continue the legacy of our Bragtown Branch as a site of lifelong learning for all. **Durham County Library Recognized with Award from North Carolina Association of County Commissioners**

Here at Durham County Library, we strive to reach the one in five Durham residents who speak a language other than English in the home. Our efforts are paying off, because our Spanish language and bilingual programs were just recognized with a Civic Excellence in Innovation Award from the [North Carolina Association of County Commissioners](#) (NCACC)!

The programs recognized at the NCACC conference included SpanishU, an intensive Spanish language course for native English speakers provided by a grant from the [Durham Library Foundation](#). Furthermore, in collaboration with Duke University's Education Program, Durham County Library provided Homework con Amigos, an after-school homework help program for children who predominantly speak Spanish in the home. Our [LearningExpress Library](#) has courses and practice exams for all major pre-college standardized tests. Also available with LearningExpress are courses to help prepare for vocational exams for a wide array of professions.

Live tutors from [Brainfuse HelpNow](#) are also available to help with preparation for the SAT and ACT and with navigating the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) process. In addition, both physical and electronic [test preparation books](#) are available to check out from all library locations.
