

The library will provide cards, envelopes, writing utensils, and stamps while supplies last. Participants will be responsible for mailing out their letter.


This program is open to community members of all ages. Registration is appreciated but not required.

Soft and serene, moss humbly dominates our environment but is often overlooked for the flashier vascular plants. Moss appears delicate, yet it thrives in some of the harshest environments in the world. Though simple in form, it supports all organisms in complex ecosystems.
